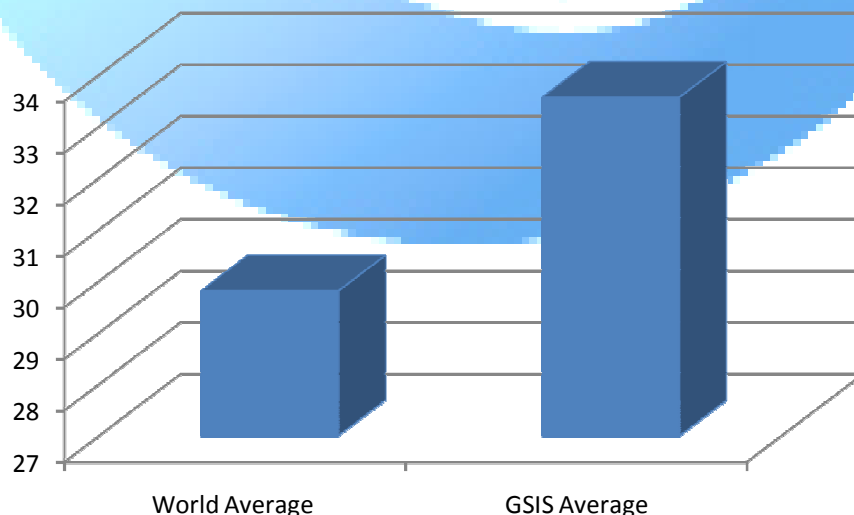


Riding High! – IBDP Results May 2013

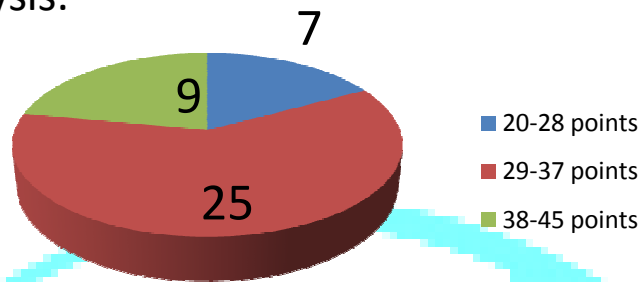
More than 1.27 lakh students around the globe received their results of the May 2013 IB Diploma Programme examination, and 41 Good Shepherd International School IB candidates have performed extremely well. With a whopping 44 points, Ujjwal Kamalia stands at the top. Second comes Arnav Agarwal and Rahul R P Nair with 40 points, and the third position is shared by Anant Sultania and B. Vignesh with 39 points.

In this session, the Good Shepherd International School average score is 33.56 points, much higher than the world average score of 29.81.



Grade point analysis:



The IB results were very encouraging with twenty-five 7s and seventy 6s. Ujjwal Kamalia earned 7 points in 5 subjects, Arnav Agarwal, B Vignesh and Aastha Jhunhunwala 7 points in three subjects, Anant Sultania, Rahul R P Nair, Vidit Kumar Agarwal and Yasmin Siddiqui 7 points in 2 subjects, Priyanka Mitesh Ghaghda, Rajamirunalini R, Aahat Sajnani and Dhruv Hitesh Vora scored 7 points in 1 subject.
