The Annual School Examinations for year one (Grade XI) will be conducted based on the question papers set by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE) and the promotion of candidates from year one (Grade XI) to year two (Grade XII) will be in accordance with the attendance and pass criteria as laid down by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations.

Indian School Certificate Examination (ISC)

(Grade XI & XII)



The Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations was established in 1958 by the University of Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate with the assistance of the Inter-State Board for Anglo-Indian Education. The Delhi Education Act, 1973, passed by Parliament, recognizes the Council as a body conducting public examinations. The Council has been so constituted as to secure suitable representation of : Governments responsible for affiliated schools in their State/Territories, the Inter-State Board for Anglo-Indian Education, the Association of Indian Universities, the Association of Heads of Anglo-Indian Schools, the Indian Public School's Conference, the Association of Schools for the I.S.C. Examination and eminent educationists.

Indian School Certificate (ISC) Examination is a public board examination conducted by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE), through the medium of English, in accordance with the recommendations of the New Education Policy 1986, after a two-year course of studies beyond the **Indian Certificate of secondary education** (Year X) Examination or its equivalent. Private candidates are not permitted to appear for the examination.

Indian School Certificate (Grade XII) is treated as equivalent to Senior Examination of the University of Scotland. This implies that pupils will no longer be required to obtain 'A' level qualifications or complete bridging courses, while seeking entry to Universities in the UK and other overseas Universities in the Commonwealth. Indian School Certificate qualification is a qualification from India that has been granted this special recognition.

The eligibility of candidates who have been awarded Pass Certificates in an equivalent examination conducted by another Examining Board will be decided by the Chief Executive and Secretary of the Council. The conditions of eligibility are as follows:

(i) **The candidate must have been awarded a Pass Certificate in accordance with the requirements of the Board at an equivalent examination taken at one and the same sitting.**

(ii) **The candidate must have obtained pass marks in accordance with the Regulations of the Board in**
(a) English
(b) a Second Language (as distinct from English) and
(c) three other written subjects, accepted by the Council.

The school will **PROVISIONALLY admit** candidates to Grade XI who has been awarded a Pass Certificate by another Examining Board. The candidate must submit certified true copies of the Statement of Marks issued by other Examining Board to the Council immediately on securing provisional admission. If the candidate is found to be eligible, the Council will issue an Eligibility Certificate to the School in respect of the candidate. **The ISC Classes for Grade XI will commence on the first week, day after the April mid-term break. For the Batch of 2019-2021, the school reopens on 8th April 2019.**
