CAMBRIDGE CHECKPOINT RESULTS APRIL 2018

CAMBRIDGE PRIMARY CHECKPOINT 2018

The Cambridge Primary Checkpoint test for Grade 6 was conducted on the 16th, 17th and 18th of April 2018 in Good Shepherd International School at the Palada campus. A total of 31 candidates took this examination.

Yet again the students of GSIS have come forth with flying colours when their mettle was tested at the highest level of academic excellence. They have once again done their school and parents proud by keeping up the school's tradition of outstanding scores.

Pranav Krishna Alapati topped the batch by achieving the maximum limit of 18 points, i.e. 6 points each in English, Mathematics and Science. M.K.Nitesh stood Second with an overall score of 17.2 points and Shiv Manish Punjabi secured the third position with an overall score of 17 points. 12 students secured a maximum score of 6 in Mathematics, 14 in the sciences and one student in English.

CAMBRIDGE LOWER SECONDARY CHECKPOINT 2018

A total of 75 students of Grade 8 sat for the Cambridge Lower Secondary on 17th, 18th and 19th of April 2018. The students were assessed in English, Mathematics and Science.

Shreyaan Jain secured the perfect score of 18 with maximum marks awarded in each of the three subjects. Adithya Nagraj secured the second position with a total of 17.6 and Ravina Jaywant Patil followed closely at third with a total of 17.4.

Five students secured a total of more than 17 and seven students' total, which fell between 16-17. 17 students secured a 6 in Mathematics and 13 in the Sciences. The best score in the Sciences was secured by Chemistry at 31 students with a maximum score, closely followed by 22 in Physics and 14 in Biology. Five students received a 5 in English and thirteen students received a 4.

The results have proven, yet again, that hard work pays off in the end.
