ICSE RESULTS 2019

The ICSE results for 2019 were released on 7th May, 2019. This year, the Good Shepherd International School family had 28 students who sat for the ICSE examinations in the month of March 2019; 24 opted for Science subjects and 4 opted for the Commerce stream. The school takes immense pride in the results with the highest average in the Science Stream bagged by Maanav Kumarpal Shah at 93.3%. The second position is shared between Kumaravel Harikaran and Harsh Vardhan at 92.7% and the third place goes to Lisa Amit Patel at 92%. Harsh Vardhan also received the highest mark awarded (100%) in Geography, Chemistry and Computer Applications. The top position in the Commerce stream goes to Suryansh Jagdish Saboo at 88%.

The hundred mark was achieved in Geography by Eve Saha, Harsh Vardhan, Maanav Kumarpal Shah, Lisa Amit Patel and Arya Gopikrishnan; in Computer Applications by Harsh Vardhan, Lisa Amit Patel, Shreyansh Agarwal and Kumaravel Harikaran and in the subject of Chemistry by Harsh Vardhan. The highest marks (90s) on an average were recorded in Computers and Geography, followed closely by Literature in English.

From the total number of candidates, 20 out of 24 received distinction, 6 received the first class and only 2 were awarded the second class. The school greatly appreciates the hard work of the teachers and all their efforts in tandem with those of the students. Such results are an outcome of the combined effort of everyone involved and the school wishes the students and their parents hearty congratulations over the successful completion of an important academic milestone and hopes for greater heights to be achieved ahead.
