CAMBRIDGE LOWER SECONDARY CHECKPOINT RESULTS

APRIL 2019

The Cambridge Lower Secondary Checkpoint exams, which provide the schools with an external international benchmark for learner performance, was conducted in the Good Shepherd International School, Palada Campus in April 2019.

Eighty-Nine students from Grade 8 attempted the exam on April 15, 16 and 17. The exam challenged the knowledge and skills of students in English, Mathematics, Science and Global Perspectives (GP). The hard work of the students was reflected in the results in all subjects including GP; with fourteen students securing Gold, sixty-seven getting Silver and one student securing a Bronze in GP, which was introduced in the year 2018.

Devikaa Thakker secured a perfect score of 18 with maximum scores in English, Mathematics and Science. In the second place was Adhik Raghuram, with a score of 16.4, followed closely by Akhilesh Sai Bikkina and Panisra Sakulsacha with a score of 16.3. Adhik and Akhilesh also secured Silver for Global Perspectives (GP). 13 students secured a perfect score of 6 in Science, 11 students scored a perfect score of 6 in Mathematics and 1 student scored the perfect score in English.

Maintaining the tradition, the students and staff of GSIS persevered to sustain its high level of excellence by an exceptional performance.

The Good Shepherd International School shines bright as a beacon once again with its performance in the Cambridge Primary Checkpoint that was held on the 15th, 16th and 17th of April 2019 at the Palada campus. A total of 41 students wrote exams for English, Mathematics and Science and for the very first time, they were also marked for skills developed through team projects as a part of 'Global Perspectives'. The school rose above all with flying colours owing to the discernible hard work and dedication of our students and teachers.

The most noteworthy achievers are Master Ronaal Sameer Patel, who topped the batch earning a score of 17.7, Master Nihar Mohan Choudary and Master Ishanya Deepak Bassi with scores of 17.4 and 17.1 respectively.

Furthermore, the students of Good Shepherd International School have made a mark on a global level as eleven students scored a 6 in Science, four students secured a 6 in Mathematics and two students obtained a 6 in English; followed by seventeen students securing a 5 in Science, twelve students with a 5 in Mathematics and seven students securing a 5 in English.

In addition to these commendable scores, 34 students of the 35 who were tested for Global Perspectives, have achieved a Silver and 1 student has procured Gold.
