## IBDP - May 2019 results

We are pleased to share the good news, that Good Shepherd International School produced the best result of all the years when 12 students scored 40 points and above, and the topper scored 44 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme of the May 2019 session. Aarya Robin Goenka scored an enviable 44 points out of 45 points in the IBDP examinations 2019.

Two students (Vijaya Lakshman Meka and Dwij Dipak Patel) scored 43 points out of 45, four (Prabhraj Singh Bhatia, Stavan Shailesh Patel, Prathmesh Fomra and Muskaan Kanoi) scored 41, five scored 40 and two scored 39 points. Of the nineteen subjects offered, there were 7's in twelve subjects. Overall, there were fifty-one 7's. The average total score was 34 and the lowest score in most subjects was 4. fourteen students scored a 3 in the Theory of Knowledge/Extended Essay combination, with sixteen scoring A's in Extended Essay and four scoring A's in Theory of Knowledge, compared to four scoring A's in Extended Essay and two scoring A's in Theory of Knowledge last year, with the same number of total students. Of the 81 Diploma students and 2 Course students, 74 were awarded Diploma and 7 were awarded Course certificates.

The IB batch of 2019 proved that the application of the ACE Learning Principles of the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC), consistent perseverance, the collaborative effort of teachers and students, peer teaching, the constant support of parents and guardians and the encouragement of all the members of the school community will certainly bear fruit.
