

IB RESULTS – MAY 2014

Good Shepherd International School has gone a step ahead in terms of IBDP results. For the first time, four of our students procured 40 points. With its mission of bringing out the best from students of diverse abilities and standards.

Those who scored 40 points were Shlok Milind Pimprikar, Aditya Vardhan Goyal, Akash Dhanturi and Suphawan Khanijou. Shamala Ravichandran scored the second highest score of 37 points and Shruti Sharma scored 36 points. Four students scored a 35. 11 students scored between 30 and 35 points.

In most of the subjects the school average is higher than the world average. The overall Diploma average of 32 points is higher than the world average.

This was evident as full marks were scored in many a component in all the subjects.
