

CAMBRIDGE PRIMARY CHECKPOINT RESULTS (2014 – 2015)

The primary school students did their parents and teachers proud with yet another outstanding performance! Displaying extraordinary maturity and determination for their age, the boys and girls of Class VI aimed for the stars and reached them!

The top scorers this year were **Aashish Prakash Parmar** and **Nabeeha Mahanta**, who achieved a perfect score of 18, securing the highest possible score of 6 points in all three subjects - Mathematics, Science and English. They were closely followed (with only a 0.1 difference) by Yugam Surana who scored 17.9 points. Maansi Suri stood third with a score of 17.8.

A team of dedicated and enthusiastic teachers brought out the best in their students and this is evident in the Checkpoint results. Out of the 33 students who appeared for the examination, 15 students scored 6 points in Mathematics, 10 students achieved 6 points in Science and 3 students gained 6 points in English.
