

# CAMBRIDGE CHECKPOINT RESULTS – APRIL 2015

The effort put in by the Grade 8 students and teachers for the Cambridge Checkpoint 2015 have reflected in the results. The overall average has shown a steady progress over the years and this year has followed the same trend.

**Siddhi Sanjeev Desai** , made us proud by securing a score of 17.8, with 6's in English, Mathematics and a 5.8 in Science. Danielle Luzanne D'souza achieved the second position with a score of 16.7. The third place was secured by Nandini Kohli and Sanjay Sajeesh Krishnan with a total score of 16.6. They were closely followed by Yashvi Navneetbhai and Saiklang Sangtrakulcharoen with both scoring above 16.

We had 14 students scoring a perfect 6 in Mathematics, 3 students in Science and 1 student in English. It was observed that 36 students obtained a 5 in Science and 25 secured 5 in Mathematics.
