The results of the IB batch of May 2016 of Good Shepherd International School have gratified us. The school takes immense pride in this batch that raised the bar for themselves with the help of the school and her teachers and scored marks far above those expected or predicted.

Of the 57 who took the examination this year, they marked an average score of 2 points on 3 in the core subjects (Extended Essay and Theory of Knowledge).
