

An Encomium for the May 2017 IB Batch

We are pleased to share the laurels of the 2017 IB batch with our readers. This year, May 2017 beheld a record number of 82 students who had enrolled for the IB Diploma examination. The highest diploma point awarded to a candidate was 41 whereas, the average grade obtained by candidates who passed the diploma was 5.04 on a scale of 7 points and the overall average score was 32 points. The result, a product of zealous efforts encompassing 27 subjects taken at various levels had 13 students who secured 7 which is the highest score awarded by IB alongside 2 students who secured 5 points which happened to be the minimum score in their individual subjects!

Furthermore, in 20 of these subjects, the school score was above the world average. It proved to be a rewarding experience for the school when 9 of our students secured 3 points in the TOK/EE combination which is the highest possible score awarded by the IB in this subject group. In addition to this, 22 students secured a 2 in the same with 16 students scoring an A in Extended Essay and 6 scoring an A in Theory of Knowledge.

During the two years IB programme, we have seen students emerge as global citizens and leaders who are caring and have a definite purpose in life.
