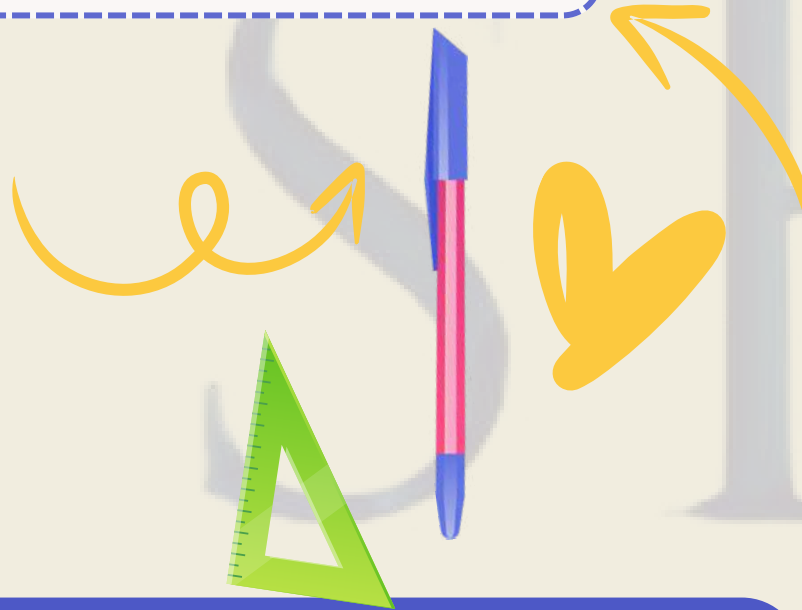
- The Power of Stories

My sincere thanks to our teachers and all support staff for their constant guidance and mentorship, and to our parents for their partnership.

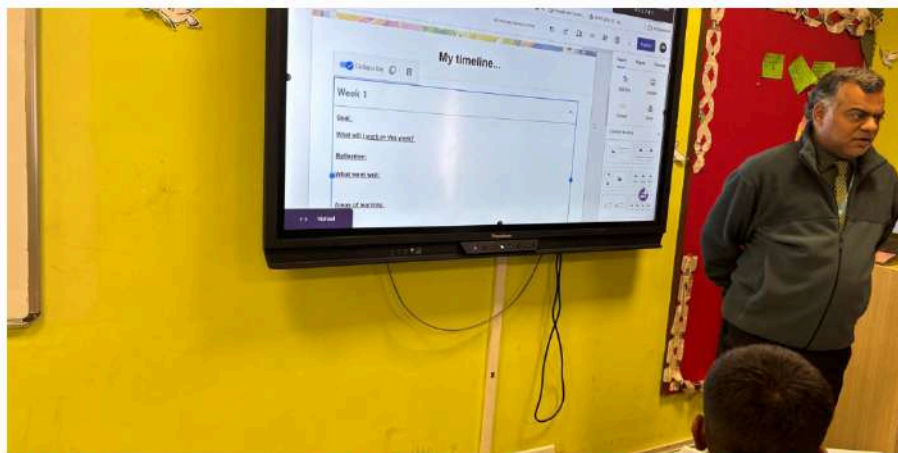

- How creativity connects people and communities

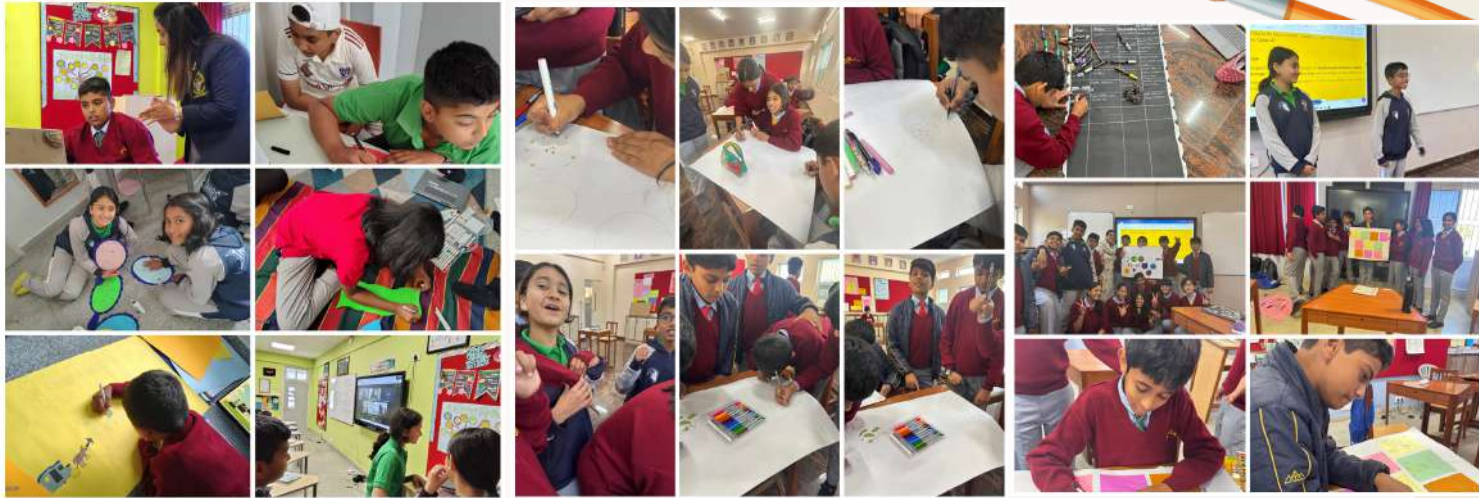
